CIGI is jubilant to have crossed three decades milestone of active, committed grassroots social development.

Centre for Competency Development (C4C)

Centre for Competency Development is an innovative project established as a part of celebrating CIGI's two decades of meaningful intervention in empowering the weaker segments of society. In 2016 CIGI took the initiative to set up 100 Centres for Competency Development (Mission 100C4C) at the grassroots level in various parts of the state. The idea of Mission 100C4C is an end result of deliberations and constant dialogues among think tanks of CIGI on the lack of competence in students and job seekers from all streams who are pursuing their higher studies or looking for a job.

The project was built on a belief that the accomplishment of this mission would provide a solution for this affecting condition and lead to a massive transformation in the current occupational and educational state of the community. By 2019, CIGI successfully completed this mission of implementing 100 centres and the project is still continuing through various activities for developing competence among the community.

A Centre for Competition instituted under C4C is basically an independent centre accredited to and monitored by CIGI and is envisioned to enhance the competency of students, nurture their talent, develop their skills, and direct them in their pursuit of a better life and career.

After shortlisting 49 strong participants were selected from different ages and finally after three days of intensive camp, we have selected convenient 20 faculties who can handle whole modules or partial modules. NMMS Camp 2018

National Means cum Merit Scholarship Scheme is an initiative by Department of School Education and Literacy for students studying in Class 9th and above. This scheme is aimed to prevent dropouts by students after Class 8th. The NMMS Scholarship can be availed by any student who is continuing education after Class 8th except, students from Navodaya Vidyalaya Schools, Kendriya Vidyalaya Schools, Sainik Schools, and Private schools.














Quality In Higher Education: A Table Talk 1

PSC Coaching for Blind Students




Webinar on 'How to Prepare for Competitive Examination

Organization Leaders Meet



Resource Persons Meet




International Leaders Meet







NIT VISIT AT CALICUT


